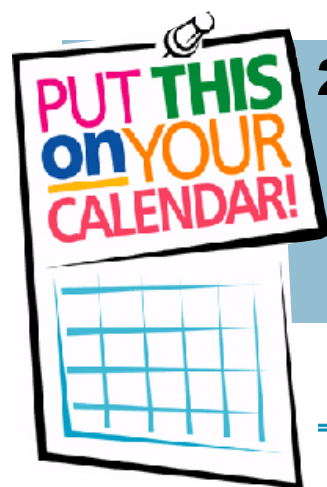

FACP is proud to partner with Institute for Organization Management, the U.S. Chamber of Commerce Foundation's professional development program for non-profit executives, and offer two \$500 partial tuition scholarships to one of Institute's 2017 sites. In addition, we are fortunate to have been given the opportunity to offer an additional \$500 partial tuition scholarship to the Southeast Institute, thanks to FACP former Board Member Ray Villegas (Seminole County Chamber), who is a Board Member of the Southeast Institute at UGA.

These scholarships, available to our members, will be awarded to students attending Institute for the first time to assist with enrollment fees. They cannot be combined with any other Institute scholarships and cannot be applied to tuition for someone who has already registered to attend.

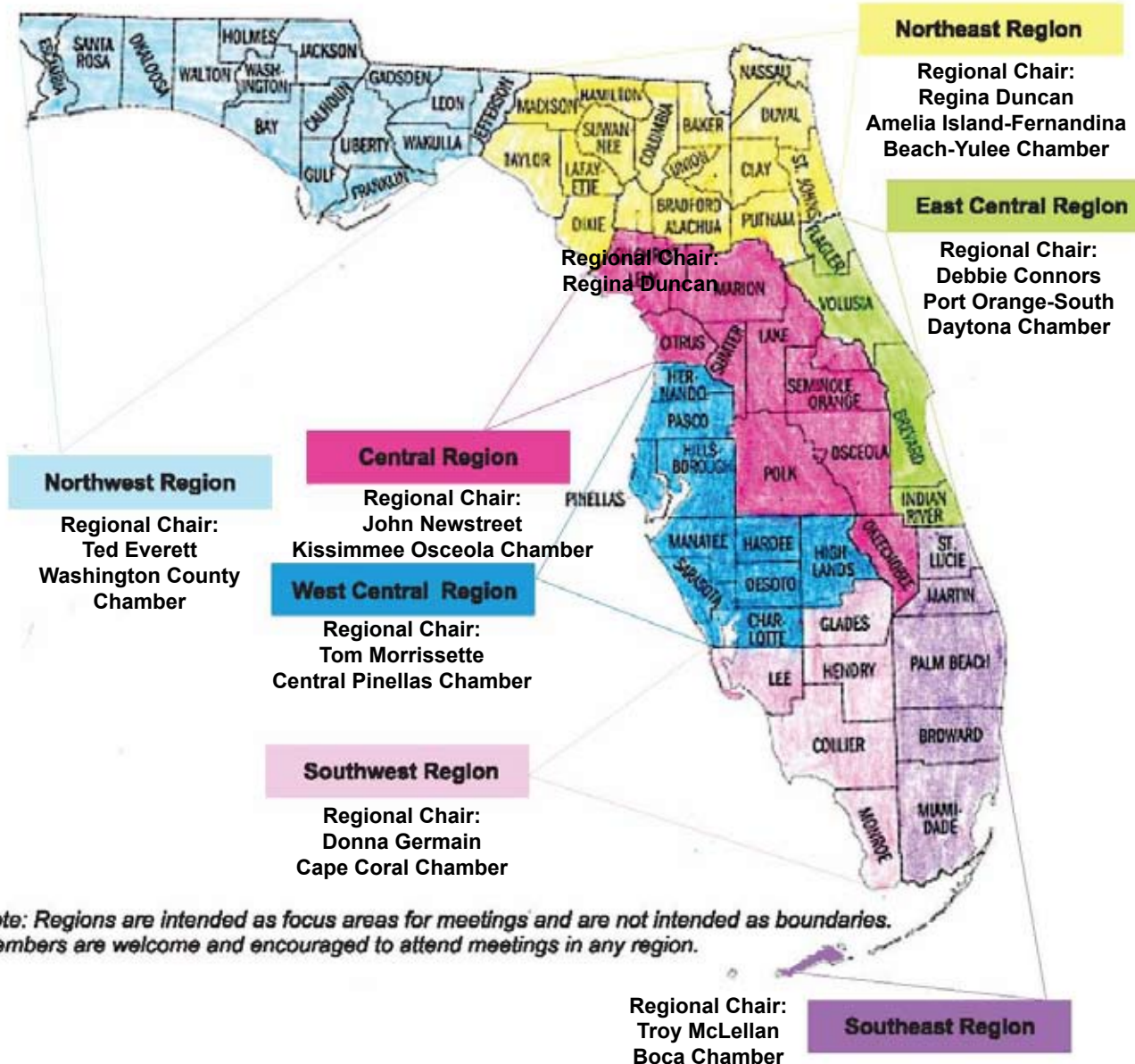
